Rotary International History:

Rotary International has over 1.2 million members worldwide with 34,000 clubs located in 200 countries. Much of our international work is funded through The Rotary Foundation, which has the highest rating, 4 stars from Charity Navigator. Rotary is most known for its mission to eradicate Polio worldwide. With partners such as the Bill and Malinda Gates Foundation, Rotary has reduced polio cases by 99.9 percent. As of July 1, 2017, there are only 8 cases of polio in the world. To reach polio free status, it requires at least three years with no new polio cases.

Newnan Rotary Club

Newnan Rotary Club was chartered on January 17th, 1924. Our membership consists of a diverse group of men and women who work, live, and volunteer in the Newnan- Coweta Community. Through leadership, local and international service projects; we work to make a difference in the lives of our community that we live and work in and our neighbors around the world.

What we do:

The Rotary Club of Newnan provides service to our community through specific projects that include The City of Newnan July 4th Fireworks celebration at Drake Stadium, Thanksgiving Dinner delivery in conjunction with Southtowne and Salvation Army, the Salvation Army Red Kettle drive, middle school career days, The Newnan High School Interact Club, Meals on Wheels delivery and The Rotary Cup Scholarship Program for our three high schools and one private high school in our community. Each year we receive grant funds from Rotary International in the form of a District Grant. Our past projects for this grant include Backpack Buddies, Coweta Samaritan Clinic, Meals On Wheels and Music and Memory. This year, we will be serving our youth with an outdoor literacy program at Ruth Hill Elementary School.
